**TCI HISTORY**

Kae Sumner (1916-1996), a 6'2" painter for Walt Disney, founded the California Tip Toppers Club in May 1938. This was the first North American tall club.

Representatives of fifteen clubs met in California in 1947 at the first tall club convention and formed the American Affiliation of Tall Clubs. This organization changed its name to Tall Clubs International (TCI) in 1966. Today, TCI is comprised of 63 affiliated social clubs located in the United States and Canada. There are also many non-affiliated clubs throughout the world.
